Lac Vieux Desert is the headwaters of the Wisconsin River and proud home of the world record *tiger musky*.

Named by French fur trappers, it means: "Lake of the Old Clearing," "Lake of the Old Garden" or "*Lake of the Old Desert.*"

The Native American people (*Lac Vieux Desert Tribe* of the Lake Superior Chippewa Indians) have lived on the lake since 1791.

This beautiful 4,200-acre boundary lake is nestled between the *Ottawa and Nicolet National Forests* for all to enjoy. **Michigan** fishing licenses and **Wisconsin fishing licenses** are *both legal* on Lac Vieux Desert.

Anglers return year after year to fish for silver and tiger musky, walleye, northern pike, small and largemouth bass and pan fish. *Watersports, hunting, fishing, hiking, biking* and *ATV trails* are right at your doorstep when you visit Lac Vieux Desert.
